Found - Orig. W.Oak now 24" S.58°E., 112.9 ft This tree had
 been previously opened, probably by Eppstein
 in 1928 & shows good scribe "S".
 Orig. W.Oak now 19" N.31°30'E., 99.7 ft. mkd. by
 Eppstein, showing two good scars. Did not open
 this tree.
 Orig. B.Oak now 24" N.33°W., 55.8 ft. instead of
 53.5 ft. as called for. This tree shows no
 scars & is starting to die.
At corner point: Set Iron pipe with brass cap marked "County
 Surveyors Office, 1959 T26S R6W ¼ S15|S14.
Corner falls in N. & S. fence line.
Blaze and scribe new tree:
