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GLO survey by William P. Heydon, Deputy Surveyor, under contract No. 656, dated May 21, 1896 - (DCSO records Vol. 11 Page(s) 4702)

Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. mkd ¼ S on N face, from which

- A fir, 36" dia., bears N.43°E., 65 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.
- A fir, 12" dia., bears N.40°W., 77 lks.

No green trees on S side of line within limit.
Dig pit 18x18x12 5½ ft. W of post.

6x6 sq. fir post 3' above ground, scribed S20, 17 ¼
15" Chinquapin N.40°W., 48.0 ft.
15" R.Fir S.63°W., 8.3 ft.

BLM resurvey by James E. Jelley & Jack W. Bowder, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group No. 763, surveyed April 1972 - (DCSO records Vol. 36 Page(s) 14874-5)

The ¼ sec. cor of secs. 17 & 20, perpetuated & recorded by Boyer, in 1952, monumented with a wooden post, 6"x6", loosely set, protruding 3 ft. above the ground, mkd. S20, S17 ¼ on N face, from which the original BTs:

- A fir snag, 53" dia., bears N.43°E., 65 lks., with axe marks visible on rotted face.
- A fir snag, 18" dia., bears N.40°W., 77 lks., with scribe marks BT visible on rotted bark blaze.

and trees marked by Boyer in 1952

- A fir, 25" dia., bears N.53½°E.. 6 lks., with partial scribe marks visible on opened blaze.
- A fir, 16" dia., bears S.63°W., 13 lks., with illegible scribe marks visible on partly healed blaze.
- A chinquapin, 22" dia., bears N.40°W., 74 lks., with scribe marks S T visible on partly healed blaze.

At the corner point
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

Found - 1972 BLM brass cap, 4" out of ground as described by Jelly and Bowder (DSCO records Volume 36, Pg 14874-5. From which:

Decayed fir snag, OBT, no marks or tag, bears N.43°E., 42.9 ft to center.

1952 BTs-40" Fir, face evident, BT tag, bears N.53½°E., 4.0 ft to center.

30" fir, face evident, BT tag, bears S.63°W., 8.6 ft to center.
