Set laurel post 3 ft. long, 3" sq., 24" in the ground for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, & 14, marked T26S, S12 and NE, R9W, S13 on SE, S 14 on SW and S11 on NW faces with 4 notches on S and 1 notch on E edges, from which

- A fir, 48" dia., bears N.85°30'W., 94 lks., mkd: T26S R9W S12 BT.
- A fir, 20" dia., bears S.80°E., 222 lks., mkd: T26S R9W S13 BT.
- A fir, 24" dia. bears S.3°W., 60 lks. mkd: T26S R9W S14 BT
- A fir, 24" dia., bears N.19°15'W., 32 lks., mkd: T26S R9W S11 BT.

The cor. of sees. 11, 12, 13, & 14, determined at record bearing & dist. from the remains of the original BTs:

- A fir stump, 50" dia., bears N.85½°E., 94 lks., with illegible scribe marks visible on bark.
- A fir, 40" dia., bears N.19¼°W., 32 lks., with scribe marks T26S R9W S11 BT visible on bark.

and BTs of which I have no record

- A fir, 10" dia., bears N.51½°E., 46 lks., with scribe marks T26S R9W S12 BT visible on open blaze.
- A madrone, 8" dia., bears S.44°E., 32 lks., with scribe marks T26S R9W S13 BT visible on open blaze.
- A fir, 14" dia., bears S.59°W., 53 lks., with scribe marks T26S R9W S14 BT visible on open blaze.

At the corner point
