- A Hemlock 8" dia., bears S.63°E., 25 lks. dist. mkd. T27S R1E S31 BT.
- A Hemlock 8" dia., bears S.45°W., 27 lks. dist. mkd. T27S R1W S36 BT.
- A Hemlock 12" dia., bears N.68°W., 20 lks. dist. mkd. T27S R1W S25 BT.
