Set a basalt stone 24x18x14", 18" in the ground for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, & 10, marked with a cross (X) on top, 3 notches on E & 5 notches on S edges, from which

- A hemlock, 26" dia., bears N.37°E., 73 lks., mkd: T27S R2E S3 BT.
- A fir, 34" dia., bears S.34°E., 134 lks., mkd: T27S R2E S10 BT.
- A hemlock, 30" dia., bears S.28°W., 58 lks., mkd: T27S R2E S9 BT.
- A fir, 6" dia., bears N.57°W., 18 lks., mkd: T27S R2E S4 BT.
