A Hemlock tree, 24" dia., for cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, & 27, I mark T27S S23 on NE, R2W S26 on SE, S27 on SW, & S22 on NW sides, with 2 notches on South & East edges from which

A fir, 36" dia., bears N.4°E., 57 lks., mkd: T27S R2W S23 BT.

A hemlock, 24" dia., bears S.44°0'E., 53 lks., mkd: T27S R2W S26 BT.

A fir, 18" dia., bears S.69°50'W., 39 lks., mkd: T27S R2W S27 BT.

A hemlock, 24" dia., bears N.52°40'W., 59 lks., mkd: T27S R2W S22 BT.

Derricks cor. for secs. 22, 23, 26, & 27, which I now destroy bears North 23°E., 456 lks.

Note - We have no record of Derrick setting this corner.

Found - Orig. 24" now 28" Hemlock corner tree, high stumped, 7' high, scribe on all 4 sides.

Orig. 36" Fir now 40" stump, N.4°E., 37.6 ft., shows scar.

Orig. 24" Hemlock, now 26" stump, S.44°E., 35.0 ft., scribed visible.

No trace of orig. NW or SW BTs.
