Found - 2½" dia., alum cap mkd: "N1/16 S2|S 1 1987 PLS 1988 DO NOT DISTURB" on a 1" OD iron pipe protruding 8", firmly set but leaning (approx) S.50°W., 0.4 ft
All following bearing & dist. measurements are from plumb position of above fd. monument.
A fd 1" Iron rod from the 1987 survey we find to be the 1" dia., threaded top of a long steel rock drill protruding (approx) 1" above ground. The top several inches of this fd drill is bent and leaning (approx) S.40°W., 0.5 ft. (We measure to plumb position) From above fd ALC/IP monument this drill mon. bears S.29½°E., 14.9 ft. (Rec. S.25°E., 14.5 ft.) Source unknown, may monument 1936 cor. position.
We search for 1936 accessories from fd drill steel but find no definitive evidence.
Evidence for the two 1987 BTs:
 A 19" Fir now a 24" dia., 1½ ft. tall sawn fir stump with a fragment of a healed upper blaze & a fully healed lower blaze; bears S.44°E., 9.5 ft. (as per rec.)
 A 16" Fir now a 21" dia., 2 ft. tall sawn Fir stump (blazes as above); bears S.73°W., 30.4 ft. (as per rec.)
Monument is returned to plumb position and is now firmly set protruding 6" above ground.
New - 5" dia., D.Fir scribed "X" "BT" on a high-low blaze; bears N.44°E., 6.4 ft.
