bears S.37½°W., 29.7 ft. (agrees w/rec) OBT  
6" now 17" dia., W.Oak, no blaze visible, bears  
N.75°W., 33.4 ft. (agrees w/rec.) 1959 BT  
Orig. 10" now 31" dia., B.Oak, no blaze visible,  
bears N.56°W., 55.9 ft. measures 58.7 ft. on
