Found Iron post 2" dia. firmly set, projecting 12" above ground with brass cap marked in 1917,  
from which the remaining original bearing tree:

A Hemlock 35" dia. bears N.40°W., 24 lks. dist. with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

bearing trees mkd. by Strickler in 1917:

A Cedar 50" dia. bears S.66°E., 53 lks with healed blaze

A Fir 24" dia. bears S.58½°W., 37 lks. with healed blaze

An unrecorded bearing tree: (probably Godfrey BT)

A Cedar 7" dia. bears N.57°E., 89 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A Hemlock 10" dia. bears S.26°W., 27 lks. dist. mkd. T27S R4W S35 BT.

The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, monumented with an iron post, 2" dia., firmly set, projecting 11" above the ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd.  
from which the remains of an orig. bearing tree

A roothole bears N.40°W., 15.8 ft., alongside of which is a hemlock trunk, 25" dia., with no marks visible and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Strickler

A cedar, 47" dia., bears S.66°E., 35.0 ft., with a healed blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 36" dia., bears S.79¾°W., 24.4 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, S.58½°W.)

and a BT mkd. by Godfrey, in 1963, reported by Jelley

A cedar, 19" dia., bears N.58¾°E., 58.7 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, N.57°E.)

and a bearing tree mkd. by Jelley

A fir, 16" dia., bears S.26°W., 17.8 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, hemlock)

and a new bearing tree

A hemlock, 4" dia., bears N.75¼°W., 27.1 ft., mkd. X BT.
