Cross on E. side of steel bridge, on truss, just above floor level bears S.19°W., 32.3 ft.
Cross on NE bridge pier side is 26.1 ft. and 23 ft. E. of center of Fowler St. to corner.

Renewal - Cross on NW bridge abutment S.75°W., 36.3 ft.
Cross on NE bridge abutment S.18½°W., 8.9 ft.
Cross on NE side of bridge pier S.8°W., 26.1 ft.
