W.Oak with a fully healed previously opened blaze bears N.66°E., 39.9 ft. (Rec. N.64½°E., 40.9 ft. to center of trunk near horizontal.) Orig. BT.</p> <p>16" Y. Oak, orig. BT, is gone.</p> <p>18" now 34" dia. W.Oak with fully healed previously opened double blaze bears S.53°E., 62.0 ft. agrees well with record. Orig. BT.</p> <p>14" now 23" dia. 9 ft. high broken top Oak, with a fully healed previously opened blaze bears S.36°W., 88.4 ft. (Rec. S.40½°W., 88.4 ft.)</p> <p>12" now 10" dia. W.Oak with a partially healed single blaze illegible scribe marks visible, bears S.37°W., 36.1 ft.</p> <p>20" now double trunked B.Oak, (Rec.
