24" now 36" dia. Madrone with a healed blaze, bears N.21°W., 23.0 ft. 1957
1957 SE BT gone.
NEW - 21" dia. I.Cedar double blazed and scribed, "T27S R7W S32 CS BT", bears S77°E, 34.6 ft.
