

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION ¼ Cor. Secs. 4 & 5

Alias _____ Description _____
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No evidence of references to orig. corner or references to 1934 and 1948 prior visits is found. From 1970 survey, found 3 references:
A 6" D.Fir now a dead 14" DBH D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze, bears S.01°W., 99.6 ft. This tree was cut down immediately after measurement of brg. & dist. was made. Stump will be removed in near future.
A 4 + with a deeply depressed center point, marked high on North face of an 8 ft. tall x 20 x 7 ft. solitary sandstone rock which bears S.½°E., 179.1 ft. (Rec. South, 179.1 ft.)
A 5/8" Iron rod, firmly set and protruding 6" above ground bears N.50½°E., 35.1 ft.
No evidence of Garrett's Iron Rod, (CS 55/138) is fd.
New BTs- 16" DBH D.Fir scribed "¼ S5 CS BT" on a double blaze bears S.42°W., 76.7 ft. distant.
7" DBH D.Fir scribed "¼ S5 CS BT" on a double blaze bears N.29°W., 90.9 ft.
Corner on small bench on lower slope of the East face of the Callahan Ridge.

Found - Brass cap per 1970 renewal.
25" Fir bears N.29°W., 90.9' - healed blaze found
BOs - 8' Tall sandstone bears South 179.1' (to 4"x4" chiseled "+")
5/8" iron rod bears N.50°E., 35.1'
New BTs- 29" Fir bears S.73°E., 40.1' - scribed "1/4 S4 BT"
20" Fir bears S.87°W., 21.6' - scribed "1/4 S5 BT"
