Point for the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 33, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A Douglas fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 32° W., 20 lks. dist., mkd. C¼ S33 BT.

An oak, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 11½° W., 41½ lks. dist., mkd. C¼ S33 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base of the stainless steel post.

The corner is located in a barbed wire fence, extending E & W. From this point, a hollow iron pipe, ½ in. diam., firmly set, projecting 18 ins. above ground, bears N. 89° 50' 00" E., 1.326 chs. dist., established by persons unknown.
