Set 1/4 Sec. post; deposited a stone 4x6x8 ins. and raised mound as per instructions.

Arthur Boyer - For: Geo. Marsh & Ned Nay. - Aug. 1966, M32-7.

Boyer shows single circle symbol - (no legend, and not labeled as 1/4 Corner) in middle of Co. Rd. # 5, 2640.8 ft. from the SW corner of section 35.
(Some other single circles are labeled as set monuments)

Don E. Garrett - For: Victor Jasper. Dec. 1968. M36-71.

Found - Iron Pipe buried in Road. He labels the pipe as the 1/4 corner for sections 34 35. Garrett uses an iron pipe Boyer set in 1966 per M32-7 as a witness to corner.
