- A fir, 14" dia. bears N.15°E. 46 lks. mkd: T27S R8W S10 BT
- A fir, 16" dia. bears S.47°E. 65 lks. mkd: T27S R8W S15 BT
- A fir, 18" dia. bears S.33°W. 80 lks. mkd: T27S R8W S16 BT
- A hemlock, 7" dia., bears N.67°W., 11 lks., mkd: T27S R8W S9 BT.
