Found - Post (fd point to rotted post) from which
10" cedar bears N.72°W., 51 lks., (missing)
12" cedar bears S.76°W., 34 lks., a cedar present, but no evidence of face or scribing.
Set - 1½" IP with brass ca marked ¼ S 2/11 BT
New BTs- 6" Fir bears N.70°W., 4.8 ft. mkd: ¼ S BT - tag "W" nail.
6" Fir bears S.31½°W., 9.2 ft. mkd: ¼ S BT - tag "W" nail.
Note - Transit survey was run from the SW cor. to the SE cor. of this section & the position for the ¼ cor. was calculated. The post was found 4.5 ft N.34°W., of the calculated position.
