Found good N-S blazed line once in a while old blaze on burnt & rotted stobs. Also fd squared stake marked with keel for ¼ cor. No trace of any orig. evidence.

Set - 1½" iron pipe with brass cap.
10" D.Fir bears N.49°E., 12.4 ft. scribed "BT"
12" D.Fir bears S.89°W., 5.7 ft. scribed "BT"

Note - Weyerhaeuser company tags nailed on BTs list the dist. & bearing from the "W" nails, set in the root collars, to the corner monument.

Found - 1979 brass cap set by Reppeto, from which:
18" Fir, face evident, WEYCO and Champion tags, bears S.89°W., 5.7 ft. to "W" nail.

New BTs- 20" Fir, scribed "S36 ¼ BT" bears N.14°40'E. 39.2 ft to spike.

18" Fir, scribed "S36 ¼ BT" bears N.57°46'E. 28.4 ft to spike.

16" Fir, scribed "S36 ¼ BT" bears S.45°04'E. 25.0 ft to spike.
