22" D.Fir at record S.20¼°E., 120.4 ft. with a well healed face and BLM tag.
Rotten 21"x 2.5 ft. tall D.Fir stump at rec S.68°E., 25.0 ft. No remaining evidence of scribe.
Root hole at record N.68½°W., 75.2 ft. Cedar BT is down and out of position.
Rotten and burned D.Fir stump at record N.19°W., 31.3 ft. burned BLM tag lying beside.
No remaining evidence of BT N.48°E., 33.0 ft.
New - 11" Incense Cedar bears S.89°E., 30.1 ft. We scribe ¼ S29 BT and tag.
5" D.Fir bears N.68°W., 12.8 ft. We scribe BT & tag.
6" D.Fir bears S.33°W., 14.4 ft. We scribe BT & tag.
Note - FD 1962 DCSO brass cap on pipe as per 2000 BLM dependent resurvey Vol. 53 Pgs 20581-20582. Top of corner monument is 0.2 feet above ground level. Monument lies on gentle east facing slope in young D.Fir plantation. Approx. 50 ft east of gravel surface BLM RD # 29-4-2.0. Existing and new BTs were measured with a tape and compass. Diameters of BTs were measured using a diam tape and are shown hereon. An averaged GNSS position was taken using TRIMBLE R121 receivers using RTK and a locally established base.
