

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION CC Secs. 20 & 21, North

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GLO Survey by - S.C. Flint, Under Contract #459, dated Aug. 3, 1882 (DCSO records Vol. 13 Page(s) 5531)  
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Set fir post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for cor. to secs. 16, 17, 20, & 21, marked T28S S 16 on NE, R3W S 21 on SE, S 20 on SW, S 17 on NW faces, with 4 notches on E & 3 on S edges; from which  
A fir, 8" dia. bears N.40°E., 18 lks. mkd: T28S R3W S16 BT  
A fir, 20" dia. bears S.65°E. 38 lks. mkd: T28S R3W S21 BT  
A fir, 12" dia. bears S.80°W. 31 lks. mkd: T28S R3W S20 BT  
A hemlock, 10" dia., bears N.10°W., 39 lks., mkd: T28S R3W S17 BT.

GLO survey by Wm. N Gibb, Deputy Surveyor, under contract No. 783, dated Dec. 3, 1908 - (DCSO records Vol. 13 Pages 5575-6)  
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*Cor. secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21, which is a stake greatly decayed, marked & witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.*  
Set dogwood stake, 3 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for cor. secs. 16 & 17 marked T28S S16 on NE & R3W S17 on NW face, with 4 notches on E & 2 notches on W edge.  
Bearing trees in secs. 16 & 17 as described.  
I destroy markings on bearing trees referring to secs 20 & 21  
Set dogwood stake, 3 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for closing cor. secs. 20 & 21, marked CC T28S R3W on S S21 on E & S20 on W face, with 4 grooves on E & 2 grooves on W face, from which:  
A hemlock, 6" dia., bears S.48°E., 111 lks., mkd: T28S R3W S21 BT.  
A hemlock, 6" dia., bears S.20°W., 85 lks., mkd: T28S R3W S20 BT.

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Found - Orig. 6" now 14" hemlock S.48°E., 73.3 ft. We open & find good scribing. Also find orig. SW BT down, shows good scar.

CC S20|S21 T28S R3W  
New BTs- 9" R.Fir bears S.14°E., 24.0 ft. scribed S21 T28S R3W CS BT.  
5" R.Fir bears S.55°W., 23.4 ft. scribed S20 CS BT.  
Note - Corner is on west slope & 100 ft. East of 2 lk. stream.
