A fir, 6" dia., bears S.41°E., 62 lks., mkd: ¼ S26 BT.

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The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 23 & 26, perpetuated by Shrum, Jr., in 1960, monumented with a rebar, 36 ins. long, ¾" dia., firmly set, projecting 11" above ground, from which the remains of an orig. bearing tree  
A roothole bears S. 41° E., 40.9 ft.  
and bearing trees mkd. by Shrum, Jr.  
A fir, 29" dia., bears N.19¼°E., 30.6 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
A fir, 19" dia., bears S.37¾°E., 40.0 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
A fir, 24" dia., bears N.87°W., 26.5 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
and a BT mkd. by person(s) unknown, reported by Shrum, Jr.  
A fir, 34" dia. bears N.1¼°W., 26.4 ft with a healed blaze  
At the corner point
