Found - 24" Pine, down & rotted, could still read markings "S 20".
Other BTs rotted in ground but some evidence of markings. Fallen trees left cavity in ground which checked for all other BTs.
½" x 30" copperweld rod set 4" out of ground for cor. point.
Marked new trees:
7" Pine N.10°W., 22.0 ft.
24" Cedar N.50°E., 9.0 ft.
14" Fir S.80°W., 22.5 ft.
Old 24" Pine, N.35°E., 71.3 ft.

Found - Orig. 24" now down & mostly rotted Pine N.35°E., 71.3' shows good scribing on section "S20".
We also find 1/2" I.R. at cor. & all BTs as recorded (Eslinger 1951)
We open his NW BT and find no scribing, small blaze only.
All other BTs show same small scar. I do not believe he scribed any BT.
I also believe tree cor. position should be should be N.35°E., 8.5'
From Eslinger's cor. For we find old stump hole, fence and stump sect. thus (Sketch shows old stump hole north of butt end of tree (down hill))
