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- Set Laurel Post cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, from which
- A Fir 10" dia., bears N.15°E., 26 lks.
 - A Fir 10" dia., bears S.80°E., 14 lks.
 - A Fir 12" dia., bears S.40°W., 62 lks.
 - A Fir 16" dia., bears N.50°W., 70 lks.

BLM resurvey by Zirpel and Glenn under Special Instructions dated Aug. 29, 1957 (DCSO records, Vol. 29 Pages 12256-57)

The Cor. determined at the intersection of the bearings from the faces of four bearing trees, of which I have no record. The scribing on these trees bear the same characteristics as those found on positively identified original cors. and by counting the growth rings on one of the meat scribed trees gives the proper date for the original survey. The bearing trees found are as follows:

- A Fir 13" dia., bears N.34½°E., 7 lks. dist., with S17 T28S R4W BT visible on an opened blaze.
- A Fir 23" dia., bears S.56¼°E., 15 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze.
- A Fir 11" dia., bears S.13°W., 14½ lks. dist., with an illegible bark scribe.
- A Fir 35" dia., bears N.41°W., 18¼ lks. dist., bark scribed S18 T28S R4W BT.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

- A Fir 18" dia., bears N.87°E., 12 3/4 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R4W S17 BT.
