Found - Both BTs as recorded by Frear & both are now partly dead. Each checks for bearing & distance. The B.O. to NW shows good scar. I do not open. Also find gun barrel at corner.
I do not set brass cap at corner.
New BTs- 8" W.Oak bears S.54½°W., 34.0 ft. scribed ¼ S12 CSBT
8" B.Oak bears S.46°E., 11.9 ft. scribed ¼ S7 CS BT.

Found - a 1" dia. octagonal gun barrel firmly set & protruding 3" from ground. Set by Frear.
Possible orig. BT stump hole containing rotted Oak wood, lies in vicinity of record call N.36°W., 26 lks.
Other orig. BT gone.
4" Madrone now a 14" DBH Madrone bears N.08°E., 10.9 Center of tree is rotted out. No evidence of blaze or scribing is found. Frear BT.
30" B.Oak now a stump rotted to ground bears N.64¾°W., 25.7 ft. In rotted fragments of trunk is found wood formerly covein a single blaze with reverse scribing, "¼ S BT". (preserved at the Douglas County Surveyors Office)

of fence running South intersect.
