

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Center 1/4 Cor. Sec. 8

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Old Field Book 33 Page 42, By ?, For ? - March 6, 1914

(May or may not be a properly set corner. Field book gives distances run that would bear out this being the center of the section but notes say scribing is 1/16's.)

Marked a post (?) on all sides for center of sec. 8, from which

- A Laurel 16" mkd. CS 1/16S bears S.73°W., 43 lks.
- A Laurel 24" mkd. CS 1/16S bears N.82½°W., 41 lks.
- A Fir 14" mkd. CS 1/16S bears N.23°E., 45½ lks.
- A Fir 26" mkd. CS 1/16S bears S.88 3/4°E., 38 lks.

Found - Monument was a wooden post, not found.

- A Laurel 16" now a 24" DBH madrone with a rotted open upper blaze & an apparent healed lower blaze, lower blaze is opened & a sound face & good "BT" scribe is fd., bears S.73°W., 28.4 ft. (As per rec.)
- A Laurel 24" now a 27" DBH Madrone with completely healed blazes (not recognizable) Tree bears N.82½°W., 27.1 ft. (as per rec)
- A Fir 26" now a 30" dia., 1½ ft. tall rotted fir stump with the remains of a lower blaze & a good "BT" scribe (blaze is oriented WNW'ly) This stump bears N.56½°E., 25.1 ft. (Rec. S.88¾°E., 25.1 ft.); stump is in middle of old NNW'ly running hillside slump which may explain bad bearing & bad face orientation.

New - The location for the monument is determined by measuring the record bearing & dist. from the fd. madrone BTs. The good dist. to the Fir stump BT could reasonably be explained by the general direction of the hillside slump.

At the above location is set a 2 3/8" dia., brass cap on 1½" OD 32" long iron pipe. Monument is firmly set & protrudes 6" above ground. MKD:

TOWNSHIP 28 RANGE 06 POINT IDENTIFIER # 240540

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A 15" DBH D.Fir scribed "C¼ S8 CS BT" on a double blaze bears S.86°E., 29.8 ft.

Note - Monument is on slight bench on fairly steep Northerly facing slope. Monument is near top of and on North side of ridge forming south side of Happy Valley.

Compass decl. 16¼°E.
