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Set ¼ sec. post, made a trench and drove a charred stake 12 ins. long, in the center, as per instructions.

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Point for Ford's standard ¼ sec. corner, located by Hathorn's record tie from the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 35.  
At the exact corner point  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 28 ins. in the ground, for standard ¼ sec. corner, with brass cap mkd:

SC ¼ S2
