(Probable 1924 GLO BT) 14" now 20" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed blaze bears N.30°E., 61.3 ft. (Rec. N.31°E., 63.1 ft.) 1969 13" now 18" dia., 1 ft. high D.Fir stump with a healed blaze, bears N.4°E., 22.5 ft. (Rec. N.4°E., 23.0 ft.) 1969 12" now 18" dia., fallen rotted Oak bears N.10°E., 83.8 ft. (agrees w/Orig. rec.) find scribing "BT".
