Set cor. secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, from which
An Oak 12" dia., bears N.42°W., 41 lks. dist.
An Oak 15" dia., bears N.17°E., 142 lks. dist.
An Oak 12" dia., bears S.36°W., 170 lks. dist.
An Oak 12" dia., bears S.65°E., 143 lks. dist.

H. L. Eppstein, Co. Surveyor - Wit: Harley Johnson; B.A. Lane; G.C. Sellers - March 4, 1930 - C.S. File 14/58 and Vol. 4 Page 9 (and "old" corner book Page 16)

Set a post for corner from O.B.T. in section 14 which had scribe marks, other trees in evidence but cut down and partly burned.

Marked the following tree:
Red Fir 12" dia. bears N.56°30'W., 86.3 ft.
No other trees near in other sections.

Douglas Co. Surveyors Office - James Byron, Deputy - Milo Godfrey; J. Fee, crew - July 31, 1957 - C.S. File 49/5-9

Found - 2" x 2" rotted Fir stake 6" above ground with scribe marks visible.
At approx. bearing and distance, N.56°30'E., 86.3 ft. found uprooted and badly rotted Fir. Scribe marks "CS S10" were plainly visible. (rec. per Eppstein, N.W.)
At S.65°E., 143 lks., found badly rotted fragments of Oak stump, one portion showed reverse scribe marks. Not legible but unmistakably scribing.

4" D.Fir N.71°W., 40.4 ft. mkd. S10 CS BT.
8" D.Fir S.65°W., 72.8 ft. mkd. T28S R8W S15 CS BT.
7" W.Oak (forked 30" above ground, dia. below fork 7") N.74°E., 29.1 ft. mkd. S11 CS BT.
8" Madrone S.67°E., 36.5 ft. mkd. T28S R8W S14 CS BT.
