Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. H/10 of listing survey No. 6-97, a tree, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor; S.4°57'W., 3 lks. from center of tree, I set a porphyry stone, 24x12x8", 14" in the ground, for witness cor. to Cor. 4 HES No. 143, mkd. WC on N face, 4 HES 143 on SE face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

    A fir 10" dia., bears S.85°45'W., 16 lks.  
    A fir 16" dia., bears N.66°00'W., 17½ lks.

Both trees blazed & scribed WC 4 HES 143 BT.  
Pits & mound impracticable at this and all other cors.  
Thence N.78°35'E., @ .04½ chains (measurement from true point for cor.)  
I set a porphyry stone, 24x10x5" in the ground, for witness cor. to Cor. 4, HES 143, mkd WC on SW face, 4 HES 143 on SE face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

    A fir, 8" dia., bears N.59°15'W., 22 lks.  
    A fir, 15" dia., bears N.65°00'W., 46 lks.

Both trees blazed & scribed WC 4 HES 143 BT.

Found - 24" Fir with the 2 orig. witness corner stones out of place. 2 BTs were established as follows:  
New BTs- A 10" Cedar N.25°45'E., 27.2 ft., scribed 4 HES 143 BT.  
          A 7" Fir S.35°W., 95.6 ft. scribed 4 HES 143 BT.

Found - 23" dia. D.Fir with a previously opened blaze on West face, illegible scribing visible. (Orig. Corner Tree)  
Two stones are found along North edge of corner tree, 2 ft. from center. One measures 14x12x8" marked "4 HES 143" on East side. The other stone measures 16x12x5" with illegible marks possible mix up in original bearings.  
No original BTs found.  
10" now 22" dia. I. Cedar with a fully healed single blaze, bears N.25¾°E., 27.2 ft. (agrees w/rec)  
7" now 15" dia. D.Fir with a fully healed single blaze, bears S.34°W., 95.6 ft. (Rec. S.35°W., 95.6 ft.)                      continued next page
