Cor. No. 9, identical with Cor. H/2 of listing survey No. 6-415, a post, heretofore described, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x11x6", 14" in the ground, for Cor. No. 9 mkd. 9 HES 143 on SE face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 20" dia., bears N.43°20'W., 101 lks.

A fir, 20" dia., bears N.2°30'W., 141 lks.

Both trees blazed & scribed 9 HES 143 BT.

Pits & mound impracticable at this and all other cors.

Looked for/not fd. DCSO VRT 12/1969 - C.S. 54/82-92: No trace due to road way & land clearing.
