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Cor. No. 16, identical with Cor. H/1 of listing survey, No. 6-590, Tract 3, a post mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x14x10", 14" in the ground for Cor. 16, mkd. 16 HES 143 on SE face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

- A fir, 12" dia., bears N.9°15'E., 69 lks.
- A fir, 22" dia., bears N.28°00'W., 31 lks.

both trees blazed and scribed 16 H E 5 143 B T.  
Pits & mound impracticable at this and all other cors.
