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Cor. No. 19, identical with Cor. H/4 of listing survey No. 6-590 Tract 3, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a conglomerate stone, 24x12x6", 14" in the ground, for Cor. 19, mkd. 19 HES 143 on SE. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which  
A fir, 8" dia., bears S.43°00'W., 36 lks.  
A fir, 15" dia., bears N.46°25'W., 19 lks.  
both trees blazed and scribed 19 HES 143 BT.  
Pits & mound impracticable at this and all other cors.
