

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Cor. No. 25 HES 143

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HES No. 143 by Frank D. Maxwell, surveyor (FS), under special instructions dated April 27, 1914 - Surveyed June 1914 - DCSO records Vol. 28 Page(s) 12025)

Cor. No. 25, identical with Car. H/20 of listing survey No. 6-97 a post mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x12x8" 14" in the ground, for Cor. 25, mkd. 25 HES 143 on NW. face, with a cross on. top; from which -

A fir, 28" dia., bears S.74°00'E., 27 lks.
A hemlock, 10" dia., bears S.9°30'E., 33 lks.
both trees blazed and. scribed 25 HES 143 BT.
Pits & mound impracticable at this and all other cors.

Found - No trace of corner stone or other orig. BT.
Orig. 28" now 36" fir stump, S.74°E., 17.8 ft. open & find scribe.
Set Brass cap at cor. mkd: COUNTY SURVEYORS T29S R1E
OFFICE 1969 COR #25 HES 143
This corner lies on east edge of beaver pond.
New BT - 17" W.Fir N.2°E., 48.8 ft. mkd: "25 HES 143 CS BT"
No other trees close.

FD BC & 1 BT, M Farr, USFS - July 1975 - M56-26

Found - 1" IP firmly set projecting 12" above ground with 1969 County brass cap properly marked.
Orig. corner stone 20"x12"x6" pushed out of place and lying on top of ground with marks "+" and "27 HES 143" visible. Corner position is on east edge of old cat road and orig. stone was pushed out of place. Corner is 20 ft. east of center of Ash Creek. Orig. corner stone & BT were erroneously marked 27.
A 36" D.Fir stump, S.74°00'E., 17.0 ft. (Rec. 17.8 ft.) with scribe marks "27 HES 143" visible on previously opened blaze.
An almost dead W.Fir, 20", N.2°E., 48.8 ft. with fragmentary scribes visible on partly healed blaze. 1969
Set - RESET orig. corner stone alongside brass cap. Add 2 ft. dia. mound of stone w/BC projecting 6" above. CONT.

TOWNSHIP 29 RANGE 01E POINT IDENTIFIER # 943250

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New BTs- A 5" D.Fir, N.62½°E., 25.4 ft. scribed "25 HES 143 CS BT" on double blaze.

A triple forked Ash (blaze on NE trunk) 8" diam., bears S.81¼°W., 50.0 ft. (to center of root crown) scribed "25 HES 143 CS BT" on double blaze. Blaze is 3 ft. off the ground.
