Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. H/5 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x10x8", 14" in the ground, for Cor. No. 4, mkd. 4 HES 144 on SE. face, with a cross on top; from which -
A fir, 20" dia., brs N.62°50'W., 46 lks.
A fir, 24" dia., brs N.8°25'W., 47 lks.
both-blazed and scribed 4 H ES 144 B T.
Pits and mounds impracticable at this and all other cors.

BC 14" in ground & built mound of stone around pipe.

Found - A 2½" dia. DCSO brass cap on a 1¼" O.D. iron pipe, protruding 15" above ground. BC/IP is surrounded by a 2 ft. dia. mound of stone. 1969
From position BC/IP as found:
20" now 24" dia. 2½ ft. high broken and rotted D.Fir stump, scribing is visible on an open blaze "BT" bears N.70°W., 26.9 ft. (Rec. N.63°W., 30.4 ft. (Orig. BT)
14" now multi trunked Maple with a fully healed single blaze on 16" dia. Northeast trunk bears N.30°W., 17.8 ft. (Rec. N.30°W., 21.8 ft. 1969
Set - BC/IP front 1969 measured 36" long, is RESET at a point of record bearing and distance from

remaining orig. BT, N.63°W., 30.4 ft... cont.

... Root crown of 1969 Maple BT bears N.30°W., 22.8 ft (Rec. N.30°W., 21.8 ft., could be a face measurement) BC/IP now protrudes 5" above ground is surrounded by a 3 ft. dia. mound of stone. The marks "RESET 1991" are added to brass cap. Found position of BC/IP is referenced with a 5/8"x30" long Iron rod with a DCSO alum, cap protrudes 3" above ground. I.R. bears N.23¼°W., 5.08 ft. from BC/IP

New Accessories -

- 7" + is chiseled on large volcanic rock, bears N.32°E., 38.05 ft.
- 7" + is chiseled on large volcanic rock, bears S.89°W., 30.10 ft.
