Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger. I mark the tree 7 HES 144 on W. face, with a blaze on the NE. and S. faces, for cor. No. 7; from which  
    A fir, 26" dia., brs N.73°30'E., 21. lks.  
    A fir, 8" dia., brs S.3°45'E., 26 lks.  
    both trees blazed and scribed 7 HES 144 BT.  
Pits and mounds impracticable at this and all other cors.
