 A hemlock, 7" dia., bears S.41°20'W., 39 lks., mkd. X 4 HES 179 BT.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. within the claim.

Cor. No. 4 of listing survey bears N.65°55'E., 2.21 chs.
