Found - 2" IP set by Victor McLind, RLS #934, in 1971,
firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, with
Brass Cap marked: T29S R1W N 1/16 S29S28 RLS 934
1971. M 42 - 39

A 10" half-dead D.Fir, N.42½°E., 6.8 ft. with S.M.
"N 1/16 S28 BT" visible on partly healed double
blaze.

A 14" D.Fir, S.19°E., 15.5 ft. with fragmentary S.M.
visible on partly healed double blaze.

A 24" I.Cedar snag, N.75½°W (Rec. S.89°W), 35.5 ft.,
with S.M. "N 1/16 S29 BT" visible on partly
healed double blaze.

Set - I add 3' mound of stone, making McLind's BC now
flush.

New - A 17" D.Fir, N.27½°W, 14.4 ft., scribed "N 1/16 S29
CS BT" on double blaze.

Note - Corner is 100 ft. South of Francis Creek on steep
North slope.
