Set an ironstone 20x10x8" 15" in the ground for cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16, & 17 mkd with 4 notches on S & E edges, from which  
 A hemlock, 14" dia., bears N.82°E., 9 lks., mkd: T29S R1W S9 BT.  
 A hemlock, 15" dia., bears S.17°E., 45 lks., mkd: T29S R1W S16 BT.  
 A hemlock, 9" dia., bears S.54°W., 35 lks., mkd: T29S R1W S17 BT.  
 A hemlock, 18" dia., bears N.71°W., 49 lks., mkd: T29S R1W S8 BT.

GLO survey by Fred Mensch, US Cadastral Engineer - Under special instructions dated June 7, 1922 - (DCSO records Vol. 15 Page(s) 6161)

Intersect the old cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, which is an ironstone, 5x10x8" above ground, firmly set, marked with 4 notches on S and E edges, and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. I obliterate marks on the NE and NW bearing trees, mark 2 notches on W edge of stone and change this cor. to refer to secs. 16 and 17 only, from which  
 A hemlock, 18" dia., bears S.17°E., 45 lks mkd T29S R1W S16 BT. (Old BT)  
 A hemlock, 12" dia., bears S.54°W., 35 lks., mkd T29S R1W S17 BT. (Old BT)  
 (South Cor. Secs. 8 & 9, only, bears N.88°55'W., 1.58 chs.)

Found - Old orig. BT, stump, N.71°W., 32.3 ft. which was destroyed but found scribing on old face.  
 No trace of stone, nor SE BT.  
 12" hemlock, down & rotten, S.45°W., 23.1 ft. found definite scribe mks.
