

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION U S L M #192

Alias	Description

HES No. 192 by Frederick W. Rase, surveyor, under special instructions dated Feb. 29, 1916 - Surveyed September 1916 - DCSO records Vol. 28 Page(s) 12068)

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From Cor. No. 1, N.78°47'W., 3.80 chs. (direct measurement) to point for USLM No. 192

Set a conglomerate stone, 30x15x6" 20" in the ground, Mkd. with a cross on top and U S L M 192 on east face.

Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, alongside. (Not sufficient stone available for larger mound.)

A fir, 36" dia., bears N.26°54'E., 19 lks.

A fir, 14" dia., bears N.45°49'W., 70 lks.

A pine, 14" dia., bears S.22°15'E., 168 lks. and

A fir, 30" dia., bears S.24°07'W., 79 lks.,

each mkd. X U S L M 192 B T.

This Location Monument is located on the highest point of ridge traversed by the trail from South Umpqua River to Emerson's ranch. It is located 36 lks. north of trail.

Ackers Butte bears S.38°30'W., about 3 miles dist.

Lat. 43°05'N., Long. 122°37'W.

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Found - Orig. Corner Stone, in place but broken, & mkd: "USLM 192"

Orig. 36", now 4.4" Fir, alive, N.27°E. 12.5 ft., shows good scar, we tag.

Orig. 14", now 20" Fir, alive, N.45¾°W. 46.2 ft., shows good scar, tag

Orig. 14", now 26" Pine, alive, S.22¼°E., 110.9 ft., open & shows "USLM 192 BT" We Rescribe "USLM 192 CS BT" above old blaze.

Orig. 30", now 38" Fir, alive, S.24°W. 29.9 ft., shows good scar, we tag

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyors T29S R2E  
(In place of old stone) Office, 1969 USLM 192

This monument lies on top of mountain. Cor.#1, HES 192 bears S.79°E., 251.9 ft. No other trees available for BTs.

USLM Ties - We are unable to see Ackers Butte old trail still in evidence & bears S. 24 ft.

Note - The Old Corner Stones set for the corners of this Homestead Entry Survey #192 are marked with small and hard to find numbers and letters.
