Set a basalt stone, 29x10x10", 19" in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 3 of this survey, mkd. 3 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which
 A fir, 24" dia., bears N.71°10'E., 50 lks., mkd. X 3 HES 192 BT.
 A pine, 60" dia., bears S.6°00'W., 32 lks., mkd. X 3 HES 192 BT.
Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. within the claim.

 15" D.Fir S.73½°W. 15.9 ft. mkd: "3 HES 192 CS BT".
This corner lies on ridge top, sloping moderately north.
