Set a lava stone, 24x14x" 14" in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor,. No. 4 of this survey, Mkd. 4 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which
 A pine, 10" dia., bears N.40°45'E., 50 lks., mkd. X 4 HES 192 BT.
 A fir, 42" dia., bears S.25°00'E., 8 lks., mkd. X 4 HES 192 BT.
Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. within the claim.
