A Cedar 9" dia., bears N.6°E., 20 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S31 BT
No other tree fit to mark.

A Cedar 9" dia., bears N.6°E., 20 lks. dist., marked ¼ S31 BT. (Old BT)
A Cedar 20" dia., bears N.17°30'W., 19 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S31 BT. (New BT)

10" dead Cedar snag bears N.6°E., 13.2 ft., found scribe.
22" Cedar stump, logged, bears N.71°W., 12.5 ft. found scribe. Notes call for N.17°W.
At corner point, found stone and Set 1¼" x 36" axle with flange up, from which
2" Fir bears S.8°W., 22.2 ft. mkd. X X X.
1½" Fir bears S.55°E., 10.2 ft., not marked.
Centerline road, West 36.0 ft. Corner lies in old logging.
