A hemlock, 26" dia., bears S.70¾°W., 36.2 ft., with scribe  
marks T29S R2W S4 BT visible on partially healed blaze.  
and a new bearing tree

A fir, 16" dia. bears S.53°E., 24.9 ft. mkd T29S R2W S3 BT
