Both BTs marked "T29S R4W E ¼ S25 CS BT."

Point for the ¼ sec. cor., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 22" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

from which
A Fir 12" dia., bears S.19½°W., 22 lks. dist. mkd. T29S R4W E¼ S25 CS BT, by Deputy Evans in 1949.
A Fir 15" dia., bears N.42 3/4°W., 24 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S25 BT.

From this point, a point established by Evans in 1949, monumented with an iron pipe 1" dia., 6" above ground, firmly set, bears S.8°30'E., 0.26 chs. dist., from which bearing trees mkd. by Evans

A Madrone 19" dia., bears S.28°W., 65 lks. dist. mkd. T29S R4W E¼ S25 CS BT.
A Fir 12" dia., bears N.64°W., 13 lks. dist. mkd. T29S R4W S25 CS BT.
