    A Laurel 16" dia., bears N.71°W., 15.0 ft.  
    A Laurel 30" dia., bears S.5°E., 50.0 ft.  
At corner point, found scribed post and Set 1" x 30" I.P., from which  
    A Laurel 6" dia., bears S.50°W., 12.0 ft. mkd. ¼ S18 BT  
    A Cedar 6" dia., bears S.42°E., mkd. ¼ S17 BT.  
Road bears East 150 ft. dist.

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Found both BTs and 1" I.P. at corner as recorded by Markham. Also find both orig. BTs with scribing as recorded except now 30" Laurel should be N.71°W., 15.0 ft., not N.60°W., 9.6 ft. This tree may have slid downhill. Markham's S.42°E. BT, dist. is 19.5 ft.  
New BT - 7" Cedar bears S.11°W., 18.6 ft. scribed ¼ S18 CSBT.

BLM resurvey by Dale T. Bedell, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group 1503, surveyed Sept. 1989/April 1990 - (DCSO records Vol. 50 Page(s) 18958-59)

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The ¼ sec. cor., perpetuated and recorded by Markham in 1951, and further perpetuated and recorded by Byron in 1962, monumented with an iron pipe 30" long, 1½" dia., set 22" in the ground, from which the original bearing trees:  
    A Madrone 32" dia., bears S.7¼°W., 70 lks. dist., with axe marks visible on opened rotted blaze. (Rec. S.5°E.)  
    A Madrone 30" dia., bears N.69°W., 28 lks. dist., no marks remaining on opened blaze. (Rec. N.60°W. 14 lks.)  
and bearing trees mkd. by Markham:  
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
