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Set ¼ sec. post, from which  
A Laurel 8" dia., bears S.56°E., 15 lks. dist.  
A Laurel 12" dia., bears N.24°E., 38 lks. dist.

BLM resurvey by James E. Jelley and Wayne L. Rogers, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #997, surveyed Oct 1979/April 1980 (DCSO records Vol. 43 Page(s) 16889-90)

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The ¼ sec. cor., perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron pipe ¾" dia., firmly set, projecting 2" above ground, from which the remains of an original bearing tree:  
A Laurel stump 14" dia., bears N.24°E., 38 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

At the corner point  
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:  
T 29 S R 3 W  
1/4  $\frac{S\ 20}{S\ 29}$   
1980

from which new bearing trees  
A Cedar 7" dia., bears N.12½°W., 65 lks., mkd. ¼ S20 BT.  
A Fir 15" dia., bears S.24½°E., 63 lks., mkd. ¼ S29 BT.  
Reset iron pipe alongside iron post.

BLM dependent resurvey by Jeffrey O. Covington, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group No. 2804, surveyed Aug/Sept 2015 - (DCSO records Vol. 58 Page 23423-5 & Plat T29-3 2017-1)

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The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd.  
from which BTs mkd. by Jelley and Rogers in 1979-80  
A fir, 23" dia., bears S.24°W., 41.6 ft., with a healed double blaze. (Record, S.24½°E.)  
A cedar, 18" dia., bears N.12½°W., 42.9 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
The iron pipe, ¾" dia., firmly set, projecting 3" above ground, reset by Jelley and Rogers, is alongside the cor.
