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Intersect the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a badly decayed post, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, with the exception that the NE. bearing tree has been destroyed. I change this cor. to refer to secs. 25 and 36, T29S R3W only and perpetuate it as follows: Alongside the old cor., Set a basalt stone 15x8x7 ins., 10" in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25 and 36, marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edge; from which  
A Fir 16" dia., bears S.65°W., 45 lks. dist. mkd. T29S R3W S36 BT (Old BT)  
A Fir 10" dia., bears N.75°W., 35 lks. dist., marked T29S R3W S25 BT (Old BT)
