14" now 22" dia. 0.Ash with a fully healed double blaze, bears N.59°E., 19.8' (agrees w/ rec.)

9" now 16" dia., 0.Ash with a partially healed double blaze, illegible scribing visible bears, N.38°W., 26.3' (agrees w/ rec.)

2" I.P. 6" below ground, bears S.87 3/4°E., 132' (rec. east 132').

Corner lies approx 70' north of S. Myrtle Co. Rd. in a N-S fence line.
