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Renewed from old BTs and marked:

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Found 2" Iron pipe at corner and both BTs.  
I blazed and scribed:  
14" Cedar S.30°W., 142.3 ft. "1/4 S20 CS BT".

Douglas County Surveyors Office - John M. Powell and crew - Oct. 30, 1968 - C.S. File 49/67-5

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Found - 2" I.Pipe in E-W fence line, pipe bent over.  
12" now 23" Alder N.31°E., 47.5 ft. shows scar.  
14" now 20" Cedar S.30°W., 143.0 ft. shows good scar  
15" Alder now down and out of place.

36" Alder BT (was 24"), bears N.32 3/4°E., (USBLM) 47.5  
ft. (this tree has scars & old C.S. BT tags)  
40" triple Alder BT, scribe marks on bark not visible,  
bears N.70°E., 58.1 ft. (USBLM)  
24" Cedar BT (now gone)  
6 foot steel fence post bears West, 1.0 ft.  
New Accessory -  
14" Alder BT, bark scribed "¼ S20 BT" bears S.49°W., 144.6  
ft.  
Note - Corner lies 100 ft. west of S. Myrtle Creek at edge  
of field.
