The ¼ sec. cor., reestablished by proportionate measurement by Markham in 1959, monumented with an iron pipe 1/2" dia., firmly set, projecting 12" above ground. There is no remaining evidence of the original corner; therefore, this position is accepted as the corner, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Markham:
A Fir snag 10" dia., bears N.10°E., 38 lks. dist. with scribe marks S4 visible on partially healed blaze.
A Fir 14" dia., bears S.60°E., 19 lks. dist. with healed blaze.
A Madrone 12" dia., bears S.6°W., 16½ lks. dist. with scribe marks ¼ S9 CS BT visible on bark.

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
